**NOTIFICATION****Subject: Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order 2017 for 'AVIATION' product.**

The Government has issued Public Procurement Preference to Make in India (PPP-MII) Order 2017 vide the Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP) Order No. P-45021/2/2017-B.E.-II dated 15.06.2017 and partially modified Order No. P-45021/2/2017-PP(BE-II) was issued on 28.05.2018, to encourage 'Make in India' and to promote manufacturing and production of goods and services in India with a view to enhancing income and employment.

2. The above orders are applicable to all Ministries/ Departments or attached or subordinate offices of the Government of India or Autonomous bodies controlled by Government of India and include CPSEs and PSUs of Government of India. Therefore it is hereby directed that Ministry of Civil Aviation and all Departments/ attached offices/ subordinate offices of this Ministry or autonomous bodies controlled by Government of India or PSUs/CPSEs shall follow the above orders in all their procurements of aviation goods and services.

3. In furtherance to the Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order 2017 notified vide reference above, following items used in-flight services shall be reserved for domestic suppliers only, if the estimated value of procurement is 50 lakhs or less, subject to sufficient capacity and competition exists domestically are as follows:-

#### 4. Verification of local content/ Domestic value addition:-

- The local supplier at the time of tender, bidding or solicitation shall be required to provide self-certification that the item offered meets the minimum local content and shall give details of the location (s) at which the local value addition is made.
- In case of procurement for a value in excess of Rs. 10 crores, the local supplier shall be required to provide a certificate from the statutory auditor or cost auditor of the company (in case of companies) or from a practicing cost accountant or practicing chartered account (in respect of suppliers other than companies) giving the percentage of local content.
- False declarations will be in breach of the Code of Integrity under the procurement rules of respective PSU/CPSE for which procuring entity may debar a bidder or any of its successors, from participating in any procurement process undertaken by it, for a period not exceeding two years. The procuring entities will maintain such list which will also be displayed on their website.
- The administrative Ministry/ Department (MoCA / DGCA / BCAS / AAI etc. as the case may be) will constitute Technical Committees with internal and external experts

whenever required for independent verification of self- declaration and auditor's/ accountants' certificates on random basis and in case of complaints.

5. In case of complaints relating to implementation of this Order is received by the procuring entity, the competent authority which is empowered to look into procurement-related complaints shall have full rights to inspect and examine all the related documents and take a decision. In case of any clarification, the matter may be referred to Board of Directors of procuring entity. As per clause 9(e) of the DIPP Order 2017, a fee of Rs. 1000/- will be charged for each complaint filed under the DIPP Order 2017.
6. Every CPSE/PSU shall annually furnish a declaration indicating the extent of compliance to the policy and reasons for non-compliance thereof to Ministry of Civil Aviation.
7. The terms and conditions shall be laid down by the procuring entity as per the DIPP Order No. P-45021/2/2017-B.E.-II dated 15.06.2017 and partially modified order No. P-45021/2/2017-PP(BE-II) dated 28.05.2018, and in its furtherance and order issued by the Government from time to time.
8. The notification comes in to effect immediately and would be reviewed as and when required. This notification shall remain valid till revised notification is issued.
9. In case of any doubt whether an item being procured is an aviation product to be covered under the Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order for aviation products, the matter would be referred to the Ministry of Civil Aviation for Clarification.
