ENFORCEMENT OF PROVISIONS OF COMPANIES ACT, 2013 FROM DIFFERENT DATES APPLICABLE FOR DECEMBER, 2024 TERM OF EXAMINATION

- 1. IMPORTANT: STUDENTS MAY NOTE THAT COMPANIES (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2018 WAS NOTIFIED ON AND EFFECTIVE FROM 2-11-2018, WHICH CONTINUED AS COMPANIES (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2019 (NOTIFIED ON 12TH JANUARY, 2019) AND THEREAFTER, COMPANIES (SECOND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2019 (NOTIFIED ON 21ST FEBRUARY) WITHOUT ANY CHANGE.
- 2. COMPANIES (SECOND AMENDMENT) ACT, 2019 WAS BEEN PASSED AND RECEIVED ASSENT OF THE PRESIDENT ON 31-7-2019. IT INCLUDES ALL PROVISIONS OF THE SECOND AMENDMENT ORDINANCE. IN ADDITION, SOME NEW PROVISIONS HAVE BEEN ADDED. NEW PROVISIONS ARE EFFECTIVE FROM THE DATE TO BE NOTIFIED BY CENTRAL GOVT.
- **3.** THE PROVISIONS WHICH WERE EARLIER CONTAINED IN COMPANIES (SECOND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE HAVE BEEN MADE EFFECTIVE FROM 2-11-18.
- 4. THERE WAS FURTHER AMENDMENT IN JANUARY 2020, WHICH IS THE LAST AMENDMENT. APART FROM FEW NEW ISSUES, THIS AMENDMENT HAS ROLLED BACK FEW STRINGENT PENAL PROVISIONS FOR NON COMPLIANCE. THE PROVISIONS HAVE BEEN EFFECTIVE BY NOTIFICATIONS ISSUED ON DIFFERENT DATES, WHICH ARE MENTIONED BELOW.
- 5. NOTIFICATION DATE OF EACH AMENDMENT MENTIONED IN THE CORRESPONDING LINE OF THE NOTIFICATION COLUMN. WHEREVER AMENDMENT IS MENTIONED BUT THE NOTIFICATION DATE IS NOT MENTIONED, IT MEANS NO NOTIFICATION HAS BEEN MADE.

ANNEXURE -A

SIGNIFICANT CHANGES AND AMENDMENTS IN MSME POLICY BETWEEN

JUNE 2024 TO NOVEMBER 2024 -

Yes, there have been significant amendments to the MSME policy between June 2024 and November 2024. Notable changes include:

- ZED 2.0 Amendments (Effective September 18, 2024): The MSME-Sustainable (ZED) Certification scheme introduced ZED 2.0, offering enhanced support to MSMEs through cost-effective measures, including a 20% reduction in certification costs. New parameters like Energy Management and Measurement & Analysis were added to strengthen MSMEs at the Bronze level. Regular assessments for Silver and Gold certifications were implemented to keep MSMEs aligned with industry standards. Additionally, financial assistance for multiple testing and certifications was introduced to provide comprehensive support to MSMEs.
- Amendment to MSME Form I (Effective July 15, 2024): The Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) revised MSME Form I, requiring specified companies to disclose comprehensive information regarding amounts due to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs). The updated form mandates disclosures on amounts paid within and after 45 days, amounts outstanding for 45 days or less, amounts outstanding for more than 45 days, and reasons for payment delays or outstanding amounts.
- Proposed Amendment to MSME Act (Introduced in July 2024): A bill was introduced to amend the Micro, Small
 and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006. The proposed amendment aims to ensure that scheduled commercial
 banks provide affordable lending rates to MSMEs, fixed at one percent plus the rate of interest for fixed deposits of the
 scheduled commercial banks. It also seeks to make it mandatory for scheduled commercial banks to offer MSMEs
 collateral-free loans up to two crore rupees.
- Launch of MSME-TEAM Initiative: A scheme to promote digitalization of trade and commerce among MSMEs, with an outlay of Rs. 277.35 crore
- **Yashasvini Campaign**: A campaign launched to achieve gender parity by 2029 on the Udyam and Udyam Assist (UA) portals.
- **MSME Hackathon 4.0**: A hackathon launched to promote adoption of latest technologies by MSMEs and expand business by supporting them in design, strategy, and execution.
- Amendments to Credit Guarantee Scheme: Enhancements to the scheme, including increased guarantee coverage for women-owned enterprises.
- Interest Equalization Scheme Extension (Effective June 30, 2024): The government extended the Interest Equalization Scheme for MSME exporters until June 30, 2024. The revised rates are 3% for MSME manufacturer exporters exporting under any HS lines and 2% for manufacturer exporters and merchant exporters exporting under 410 HS lines. An additional outlay of ₹2,500 crore was approved to cover the scheme until the extended date.
- Rajasthan MSME Policy 2024 (Effective September 2024): Rajasthan introduced the MSME Policy 2024, focusing
 on improving the business environment for MSMEs. The policy includes fiscal benefits and incentives as per the
 Rajasthan Investment Promotion Scheme, 2024 (RIPS-2024). It also aims to enhance the participation of Scheduled
 Castes (SC) and Scheduled Tribes (ST) in economic development through the Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Rajasthan Dalit,
 Adivasi Udyam Protsahan Yojna (BRUPY).
- **Telangana MSME Policy 2024 (Effective September 2024):** Telangana launched the MSME Policy 2024, identifying six thrust areas for improvement:
 - 1. Improving availability, accessibility, and affordability of credit.
 - 2. Enhancing infrastructure and industrial parks.



- 3. Promoting innovation and technology adoption.
- 4. Facilitating market access and exports.
- 5. Providing skill development and training.
- 6. Ensuring ease of doing business.
- The Employment Generation Programme of the Prime Minister (PMEGP): By giving beneficiaries who take out bank loans to start new businesses with a maximum project cost of Rs. 50 lakh in the manufacturing sector and Rs. 20 lakh in the service sector Margin Money (subsidy) is one way that PMEGP, a credit-linked subsidy scheme, creates jobs by establishing micro-enterprises in the non-farm sector. Applications for the PMEGP have been accepted in 11 regional languages since January 2024. Since the beginning, that is. With the distribution of the Margin Money subsidy of Rs. 26,124.26 crore from FY 2008-09 to FY 2024-25 (as of 24.12.2024), over 9.87 lakh microbusinesses nationwide have received assistance, creating an estimated 80 lakh jobs overall. During FY 2024-25 (as on 24.12.2024), 58,028 new micro enterprises have been assisted across the country with disbursement of Margin Money subsidy of Rs. 2018.97 crore, generating a total estimated employment for more than 4.6 lakh persons.

SRI Fund

Self-Reliant India Fund Scheme of the Ministry of MSME provides equity funding to those MSMEs which have the potential and viability to grow and become large units. Since its operationalization in October 2021 till date, 57 Daughter Funds have been empaneled with NSIC Venture Capital Fund Limited (NVCFL), i.e. Mother Fund. SRI Fund has assisted 523 MSMEs by way of investment of Rs. 9,623 crore.

From 1st January, 2024 to 30th November, 2024, 06 daughter funds were empaneled with NVCFL. More than Rs. 2,701 crore has been invested to assist 115 potential MSMEs.

- Infrastructure & Capacity Building
- Micro and Small Enterprises Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP)
- Out of the 609 approved projects, 29 projects, with a total project cost of approximately Rs. 601 crore, with Government of India's assistance of Rs. 392 crore were approved during the period January 2024 to December 2024.

Procurement and Marketing Support (PMS) Scheme: 43rd India International Trade Fair (IITF)-2024

- Promotion of MSMEs among SC/STs and in NER
- National SC-ST Hub (NSSH)
- Promotion of MSMEs in NER and Sikkim Scheme
- RAMP Scheme:32 States/UTs have submitted Strategic Investment Plans (SIPs) of which 31 SIPs have been evaluated and more than 200 proposals, worth about Rs.3000 Crore have been approved for the States/UTs. Since inception, all initiatives under RAMP have impacted more than 4 lakh MSMEs. The Ministry has achieved 50% of the programme target in respect of claiming reimbursement, on account of completion of deliverables.
- In current FY till 30.11.2024 the KVI production of Rs.76017.79 Crore (P) has been achieved.
- Special Campaign 4.0
- MoU signed with Egypt
- Mahatma Gandhi Institute for Rural Industrialization (MGIRI)
- National Institute for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (Ni-MSME): Major Activities and Achievements are: In all, over 350 national and international programmes were conducted by the Institute during the year 2024-25 involving 10,800 participants.

1. Advisory on AI Content Regulation (March 15, 2024):

The Government of India issued an advisory emphasizing the due diligence required by AI platforms and intermediaries under the Information Technology Act, 2000, and the IT (Intermediary Guidelines and Digital Media Ethics Code) Rules, 2021. The advisory outlined responsibilities to prevent the dissemination of unlawful content, including: Prohibiting users from hosting or sharing unlawful content. Ensuring AI-generated content does not exhibit bias or discrimination. Preventing content that could undermine the electoral process. Labeling AI-generated content to disclose potential inaccuracies.

2. Finalization of Telecom Cyber Security Rules (November 21, 2024):

The Department of Telecommunications (DoT) finalized the Telecommunications (Telecom Cyber Security) Rules, 2024, replacing the earlier draft from August 28, 2024. Key updates include:

- Introduction of the term 'certified agency' for standardized security audits.
- Establishment of a digital portal for the Central Government to issue orders and communications.

These rules are designed to strengthen the security of India's telecom networks and services.

3. Clarifications on Cybersecurity Framework for SEBI Regulated Entities (December 31, 2024):

The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) issued clarifications to its Cybersecurity and Cyber Resilience Framework (CSCRF) for regulated entities. These clarifications provide guidance on:

- Implementation of cybersecurity measures.
- Reporting and managing cyber incidents.

The aim is to enhance the resilience of entities under SEBI's jurisdiction against cyber threats.

4. National Registry of Suspected Cyber Criminals (September 10, 2024):

India announced plans to establish a national registry for suspected cyber criminals and deploy approximately 5,000 "cyber commandos" over the next five years. These experts will collaborate with police and regional authorities to combat cybercrime more effectively.

These developments reflect India's ongoing efforts to enhance cybersecurity through legislative updates, regulatory clarifications, and strategic initiatives.



ANNEXURE - C

Legislative and Regulatory Developments (June–November 2024)

Between June and November 2024, India and the United States introduced significant legislative and regulatory amendments aimed at strengthening their financial and disaster management frameworks. These changes reflect a broader effort to enhance governance, improve resilience, and address emerging challenges in their respective sectors.

India: Banking Sector Reforms and RBI's Regulatory Measures

Banking Laws (Amendment) Bill, 2024

Introduced in the Lok Sabha on August 9, 2024, and passed during the Winter Session on December 3, 2024, this bill brought key amendments to multiple banking laws to modernize India's financial system and improve governance.

1. Reserve Bank of India (RBI) Act, 1934:

- The bill redefined the term **"fortnight"** for the purpose of maintaining cash reserve ratios (CRR) by banks.
- Earlier, a fortnight was a fixed two-week period. The amendment now specifies it as either the 1st to the 15th or the 16th to the last day of each month.
- This change ensures greater clarity and uniformity in how banks calculate and maintain their CRR.

2. Banking Regulation Act, 1949:

- The amendment extended the **tenure of cooperative bank directors** (excluding the chairman and whole-time directors) from **8 years to 10 years**.
- This aligns with the Constitution (Ninety-Seventh Amendment) Act, 2011, which emphasizes governance reforms in cooperative institutions.
- The change is aimed at **enhancing stability and experienced leadership** in the cooperative banking sector.
- 3. State Bank of India Act, 1955, and Banking Companies (Acquisition and Transfer of Undertakings) Acts of 1970 and 1980:
 - While specific changes were not detailed, the amendments focused on modernizing banking operations, strengthening governance, and improving depositor convenience to align with global best practices.

Regulatory Actions by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI)

In addition to legislative amendments, the **RBI introduced key regulatory measures** to address financial stability concerns:

1. Microfinance Loan Regulations (November 2024):

- The RBI restricted banks from issuing fresh microfinance loans to borrowers who already have outstanding loans.
- The move aimed to curb the practice of "evergreening" loans, where borrowers take new loans to repay existing ones, masking financial stress.
- While promoting financial discipline and transparency, the restriction also raised concerns about potential defaults, as many low-income borrowers rely on multiple loans for repayments.
- 2. **Caution to Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs) (October 2024):**
 - RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das warned NBFCs against adopting a "growth-at-any-cost" approach, which could pose financial stability risks.
 - The central bank closely monitored aggressive lending and high return-seeking behaviors in the NBFC sector.
 - The RBI signaled its **readiness to take regulatory actions** if such risks escalated.

These reforms indicate India's push toward stronger banking governance, financial discipline, and regulatory oversight to ensure stability in the sector.



FEMA Policy Updates and Disaster Management Reforms

Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Policy Updates

1. Implementation of the Federal Flood Risk Management Standard (FFRMS) (July 11, 2024):

- FEMA published a final rule to enforce the FFRMS, aimed at reducing flood risks for federally funded projects by incorporating anticipated future changes in flood patterns.
- The rule became effective on September 9, 2024, and applied to:
 - New construction projects
 - Substantial improvements or repairs of flood-damaged structures
 - Hazard Mitigation Assistance projects, such as structure elevation, dry floodproofing, and mitigation reconstruction

2. Fiscal Year 2024 Shelter and Services Program (SSP-A) Amendments:

- FEMA set a September 11, 2024, deadline for state and local governments to submit amendments to their FY
 2024 SSP-A awards via the FEMA GO system.
- This funding supported **emergency shelter services** for communities affected by disasters.

3. **Pre-Disaster Mitigation Funding:**

- In FY 2024, FEMA allocated \$190.57 million to fund 110 congressionally directed pre-disaster mitigation projects.
- These funds aimed to reduce the impact of future disasters by investing in preventive measures such as infrastructure resilience and community preparedness programs.

Legislative Developments in Disaster Management

1. **FEMA Equity Act (S.2961) – Addressing Disaster Relief Disparities:**

- Introduced during the 118th Congress (2023–2024), this bill sought to ensure equitable access to disaster assistance, particularly for historically underserved communities.
- As of **November 2024**, no amendments had been introduced, but the bill remained an essential part of the legislative debate on fair distribution of FEMA aid.

Disaster Response and Funding Challenges

- 1. Hurricanes Helene and Milton (October 2024):
 - These hurricanes caused severe damage in Florida, North Carolina, and South Carolina.
 - FEMA extended the deadline for affected residents to apply for assistance to January 7, 2025.

2. Funding Shortfalls and Emergency Appropriations:

- In October 2024, Homeland Security Secretary Alejandro Mayorkas warned that FEMA lacked sufficient funds to cover the remainder of the hurricane season.
- In November 2024, President Joe Biden formally requested \$98 billion from Congress to replenish FEMA's disaster relief funds, highlighting the urgency of financial support for recovery efforts.

Political Controversies in Disaster Relief Funding

- 1. Allegations of Misallocated Funds:
 - Former President Donald Trump alleged that FEMA disaster relief funds were being diverted to support irregular immigration policies.
 - FEMA denied these claims, clarifying that disaster relief funds had not been redirected for any other purpose.



Conclusion

The period from June to November 2024 saw **major legislative and regulatory developments** in both India's financial sector and the United States' disaster management policies.

- India's banking reforms focused on modernizing financial regulations, improving governance in cooperative banks, and strengthening RBI's regulatory oversight on microfinance lending and NBFCs.
- The United States, through FEMA, implemented new flood risk standards, expanded disaster mitigation funding, and faced financial shortfalls in disaster response, leading to a presidential request for \$98 billion in emergency funds.
- Both countries faced policy controversies—India over loan regulations, and the U.S. over alleged misallocation of disaster relief funds.

These legislative and regulatory shifts underscore the ongoing evolution of governance frameworks to tackle financial and disaster-related challenges effectively.



ANNEXURE - D

Prevention of Money-laundering (Maintenance of Records) Amendment Rules, 2024: Date: August 1, 2024

Key Points:

Reporting entities must obtain the KYC Identifier from clients or the Central KYC Records Registry to retrieve KYC records.

Clients are not required to resubmit KYC records unless there are changes, incomplete records, or expired documents.

KYC records must be updated within seven days or within a period notified by the Central Government.

SEBI's Master Circular on Anti-Money Laundering (AML) Standards:

Date: June 26, 2024

Key Points:

Securities market intermediaries must follow AML standards and combat financing of terrorism under the PMLA.

Requirements include customer due diligence, maintaining records, and reporting suspicious transactions.

RBI's Notification on KYC Norms and AML Standards:

Date: September 12, 2024

Key Points:

The RBI issued instructions to align KYC norms and AML standards with recent amendments to the PMLA Rules.

Financial institutions are required to update their procedures in compliance with the new regulations.
